

Handwritten Book Checklist

Create a book of your original compositions and arrangements! Your book can be handwritten or [engraved](#) using a music writing software like [Noteflight](#).

- Decide on the songs you want to include in your book with your teacher. You can include:
 - Original Compositions
 - Transpositions
 - Arrangements
 - Variations
- Set a release date for your book with your teacher.
- Write out each song. Each page should include:
 - Song title
 - Composer or origin
 - Arranger (you!)—if applicable
 - Page number
- Create a table of contents.
- Create a cover page with artwork.
- Create an author page that includes a short biography of yourself.
- Bind your pages together to create a physical book, or scan each page to create a digital book on Book Creator (or do both!).
- Ask your teacher to fill out the announcement form to share your book with Orpheus.

★ BE A PRO GUIDELINES

- Make sure your handwriting is neat.
- Add a photo or illustration of yourself to the author page!
- Create extra illustrations for some of your songs!
